- English Proficiency: for the applicant whose native language is not English, the results of the TOEFL (Educational Testing Service, Box 995, Princeton, NJ 08540, USA) are required. The results of the TOEFL must be received on or before the Department of Construction Management's application deadline. A score of 550 or higher is required.
 - *G.R.E. scores*: (Aptitude Test scores of the Graduate Record Examination) must be received on or before the application deadline.  - A Personal-Résumé or Curriculum Vitae is required of applicants to provide further background addressed to the Admissions Committee.
 - Three letters of recommendation must be received on or before the application deadline. The names of persons contacted for letters may be entered in the space provided below:
