### CONFERENCE LOCATION

The Conference will be held on the University of Washington campus in the Husky Union Building (HUB) South Ballroom, Room 211. The UW Campus is located just north of downtown Seattle and convenient to and from the Sea-Tac Airport using the UW Link Light Rail.

# **DIRECTIONS (Map on page 3)**

To the UW from Sea-Tac Airport:

Link Light Rail: Sea-Tac Airport has a Light Rail station which goes directly to University of Washington.

- To get to the Link from baggage claim, go up one floor, head to the skybridge at the north end of the terminal, go left through the parking garage and follow signs to the light rail station. Take the Link to the University of Washington Station.
- At the UW Station, the distance to the hotels and dormitory is about a 20 min. walk or a 7 min. car/taxi ride. For public transit options, please see ground transportation.

Driving: Take the 518 E Airport Expressway, keep right at the fork for 1-5 North for 15 miles, take exit 168B for WA-520 toward Bellevue/Kirkland, and take the Montlake Blvd exit.


# **GROUND TRANSPORTATION**




