






Understanding Risk for Better Training



The Risk Information System for Commercial Fishing (RISC Fishing) is used to provide NW commercial fishery stakeholders with useful information on the hazards unique to this industry. Vessel and casualty information are translated into risk assessments. This has led to the creation of safety trainings, including FFAST, a Fishermen First Aid and Safety training, that match the needs and real experiences of fishermen.
