# **Call for Proposals**

### • Outreach Mini-Grants - \$2,000 to \$7,500

Provides funding opportunities for industry and community organizations to launch education activities. Examples include:

- · Delivering health & safety trainings or workshops
- Expanding existing outreach activities
- Enhancing workplace safety program
