



The Montgomery County Quiet Skies Coalition (MCQSC) of Maryland is a nonprofit organization founded in 2016 to reduce the untenable noise and other impacts of newly concentrated flight patterns imposed on our communities by the FAA's flight procedures at Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA). Five years into our efforts, new flight procedures which mitigate noise are finally being seriously considered by the FAA thanks to the collaboration we have put in place working with an aviation consultant. The aviation consultant, a former FAA Air Traffic Controller and RNAV procedure designer, works with our communities to develop, analyze, and propose new flight procedures for noise mitigation and simultaneously interfaces with the FAA, the airport, and the airlines on our behalf. **Anne Hollander**, President of MCQSC, will briefly discuss the community-building and political efforts that laid the groundwork for these successes and the results that have been achieved to date.
