



Dominique Lazarski, *President*, UECNA

Dominique Lazarski is the president of UECNA - European Union Against Aircraft Nuisance, the sole European umbrella NGO representing communities across Europe aiming at tackling noise and air pollutions from aviation. She is a member of experts groups of the European Commission, the Noise Experts Group with DG Environment and of the European Observatory on Airports Capacity and Air Quality with DG Move. Dominique sits on the Advisory Board of ANIMA project and is also a member of working groups 1 (Noise Technical) and 2 (Airports and Operations) representing environmental NGOs of ICAO's environmental committee (CAEP).

Dominique Lazarski is also an active member of various NGOs addressing communities issues in relation with aviation in France and sits on various French Airports environmental committees.

Like all her colleagues in the same NGOs, her activities are on a volunteer basis.

She is also Vice-President of UFCNA, French union against aircraft nuisances, an umbrella NGO for French residents associations, and president of ADERA, a local residents' organization near Paris-Beauvais airport in France. She is a member of the steering committee of the coalition of environmental and residents' associations in the Paris area called Convergence Associative d'Ile-de-France.
